Letizia Moratti is President of the National Secretariat Council of Forza Italia and a Member of the European Parliament within the European People's Party - Forza Italia group.

She serves on the Committee on Employment and Social Affairs (EMPL), the Committee on the Environment, Climate and Food Safety (ENVI), the Committee on Public Health (SANT), and the Committee on Industry, Research and Energy (ITRE). She is also a member of the Delegation to the OACPS–EU Joint Parliamentary Assembly (DACP) and the Delegation to the Africa-EU Parliamentary Assembly (DAFR).

She previously served as Regional Councillor for Welfare and Vice President of the Lombardy Region, Mayor of Milan- during which she secured the award of Expo 2015 to the city - Minister of Education, Universities and Scientific Research, and President of RAI.

From 2016 to 2020, she served as Chair of the Management Board and the Board of Directors of UBI Banca.

She is co-founder of the San Patrignano Foundation. She also founded and chairs the E4Impact Foundation, which supports the development of social impact entrepreneurs across Africa.

In addition, she founded and serves as President of the Genesi Association, dedicated to the promotion and defense of human rights through contemporary art.
