She is currently the Chief Strategy Officer (CSO) of TIRME, being in charge of company activities related to Sustainability, Circular Economy, Environment and Climate, Quality, Human Resources and Occupational Health & Safety. She is also a professor lector at the University of the Balearic Islands in the Chemistry Department.

She cooperates with the Spanish Association of Municipal Waste to Energy Plants (AEVERSU) since 2003. In this role she also participates in meetings and working groups both at a national and at European level. Chairwoman of the working group on Emission Control at the Confederation of European Waste to Energy Plants (CEWEP). She has also act as advisor in the last revision of both the Waste Incineration and Waste Treatment BREF documents, being member of the corresponding Technical Working Groups set up by the European IPPC Bureau.

Co-author of three books and two book chapters related to the automation of environmental analytical methods, with more than 10 research articles published and approximately 30

contributions presented in international conferences related to the environment. She has participated in several research projects of the European Union, Spanish, and Regional Governments.
